Destination Experiences Booking Deadline

All Destination Experiences (DE's), private arrangements and transfers must be booked no later than 72 hours prior to arrival in port unless otherwise stated. Reservation inquiries received less than 72 hours in advance will be accommodated on a request basis, pending availability. To avoid disappointment, it is recommended that reservations be made as early as possible.

Pricing

A minimum number of participants is required to operate DE's, including Overland or Overnight Journeys. Although all itineraries described are expected to be operated as shown, *The World* reserves the right to adjust, alter, or substitute hotels, flights, transportation and restaurant reservations of similar quality when necessary or cancel itineraries to meet local conditions for the convenience and safety of the participants Pricing includes meals and refreshments as indicated in the program description, plus guides and entrance fees unless otherwise stated. Gratuities for guides and drivers are included. Prices do not include food and beverages not specified in the program description or any expense incurred should you elect to leave the program before it is completed

Overland and Overnight Experiences Deadline

Overland and Overnight Experiences carry various reservation deadlines. Please contact The World Concierge directly for specific terms and conditions and pre-departure information such as flight details, deposit, cancellation penalties, etc.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

All DE's, Overnight Experiences, Overland Journeys and private arrangements are subject to penalties if cancelled after the established booking deadlines. Any refund is subject to the resale of space; otherwise no refund may be granted.

Departure and Meeting Times

As a courtesy to fellow Residents & Guests, kindly adhere to the meeting/departure times as indicated by either the Ship's escort or Guides during each Experience.

Transportation

Every attempt is made to secure the best available vehicles and guides in each port of call. As *The World* travels to many remote destinations, there may be ports where the best equipment may not be up to the luxury standards normally available.

Shuttle Service

Complimentary transportation is available when the local town center is located beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists. The availability and schedule for this shuttle service will be provided by The World Concierge.
