As the days grow long and the nights become bright, *The World* will forge northward into Scandinavia along the sinuous coastline of Norway studded with secret coves, the rugged beauty of the Faroe Islands, and Iceland's Viking mysteries. Residents will embark on an incredible Arctic expedition to Greenland and Ellesmere Island / Baffin Coast followed by a journey down the eastern coasts of Canada and North America, from Norse archaeology on Newfoundland and the quaint villages of Cape Cod, to the fast-paced metropolis, New York City.

The World's intrepid explorers will sail to the Caribbean, Bermuda, the Bahamas, and the Cayman Islands en route to an immersive introduction to South America. After transiting the Panama Canal to the paradise of western South America, the ship will make stops in Ecuador before discovering the intriguing Inca legends of Peru, and the soaring Patagonian mountains that form a spine between Chile and Argentina. The year concludes with two unforgettable expeditions in Antarctica, the most pristine region on the planet, where residents and guests will take in breathtaking scenery, a coastline packed with raw beauty and wildlife, Zodiac cruising, hiking, kayaking, and a spectacular backdrop in which to celebrate the New Year.

Greenland and Ellesmere Island / Baffin Coast Expedition

This incredible expedition traverses fjords, rugged mountains and viking ruins. As the snow thaws, the landscape of Greenland is revealed, and wildlife emerges with whales visible off the coast and flocks of migrating birds arriving to mate. The sea ice breaks to uncover clear, crisp waters and floating icebergs through which to kayak while the wild-flower threaded mountain trails are unveiled. Wildlife viewing abounds; polar bears, muskoxen, humpback whales, sea eagles and reindeer all call this

remote island home. On Canada's wild Baffin Coast, there are immense glacial systems, and the history of early Arctic exploration comes alive. Native Innuit communities offer a fascinating firsthand insight into the unique culture born out of the surrounding wilderness.

Antarctica Expeditions

As the last continent to be discovered by humans, Antarctica is easily the most pristine part of our planet.
