

The World, Residences at Sea calls on Hawaii

Residents return to the island paradise

[LONDON, England, October 2024] – <u>The World, Residences at Sea</u>, the largest privately owned residential mega yacht on Earth, is pleased to announce it will be calling on Hawaii in December 2024 where its Residents will enjoy extended stays in five ports of call during its 10-day journey across the island state. Residents of the one-of-a-kind ship will experience Hawaii's rich native art and culture, fascinating customs, cuisine, biodiversity and more during stops in Honolulu (Oahu), Nawiliwili (Kauai), Kahului (Maui), Kailua-Kona (Hawaii Island) and Hilo. *The World* last visited the Aloha State in January 2022. The sojourn is part of the ship's spectacular 2024 voyage to six continents including Antarctica, South and East Africa, South Asia, Indonesia, South Pacific and Australasia.

The ship's arrival in Hawaii comes after an incredible expedition in January to Antarctica and the Falkland Islands where some Residents experienced a once-in-a-lifetime journey to explore the South Pole, followed by South America where Residents visited Buenos Aires, Rio de Janeiro, and the volcanic islands of Tristan da Cunha in February. March found Residents exploring the eastern coast of Africa, immersed in cultural traditions in Tanzania, Kenya, South Africa, and Mozambique, before heading to the Seychelles, Maldives, and Sri Lanka. The Asian leg of the journey included visits to India, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Cambodia and Vietnam before spending time in Hong Kong, Shanghai, Seoul, Nagasaki, Tokyo, Taiwan, the Philippines, and Indonesia.

The World's call to Hawaii follows two remarkable expeditions to the Kimberley and Papua New Guinea and the Solomon Islands. While discovering the Kimberley, Australia's most remote and mysterious coast, Residents explored long canyons by Zodiac, Mitchell Falls by helicopter and the Bungle Bungles, a unique and extensive range of rock formations only formally documented in the mid-1980s, by plane. The landscape, ancient art forms, wildlife, and tidal features were the defining highlights of this stunning region and remote coastline that few have seen. In Papua New Guinea and the Solomon Islands, a circuitous route allowed for experiences that uncovered the fascinating cultures that populate these remote islands. Residents seized every opportunity to go hiking, access cultural performances, scuba dive, snorkel, and swim.

Resident owners of this private community at sea enjoy the ultimate combination of enriching travel to approximately 100 ports of call a year, complemented by world-class amenities, state-of-the-art facilities, and anticipatory service – all from the comfort of their homes on board. The only ship of its kind in operation, *The World* offers a unique ultra-luxury lifestyle of global exploration that is internationally renowned for its journeys to many of the planet's most remote and undiscovered areas as well as to bustling cosmopolitan cities. The ship's Residents determine its yearly itinerary by a community-wide vote. Extended stays averaging three days in port ensure sufficient time to explore favorite destinations. Unlike most passenger vessels, *The World* spends nearly twice as many days in port as at sea. Every few days Residents awake to a new and exciting port of call outside their window.

On *The World*, Resident owners can travel the globe in complete luxury from the comfort of home. Offering an incomparable ease of travel, they can spend the day exploring and return to their own private residence in the evening – no packing and unpacking required, no planes or trains. Exploring the world has never been easier. *The World* is a complete floating city, equipped with high-end facilities and luxurious amenities that create an intimate, refined atmosphere. The ship's warm and inviting ambience is much like that of a private yacht, well-staffed private home, or exclusive country club. The strikingly beautiful and well-appointed ship offers personalized, anticipatory service and amenities by an extraordinary crew who know each Residents' preferences.
